




# The West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine



## Seeking ANATOMY FACULTY

The Division of Structural Biology at the West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine invites applicants for a tenure-track position in Human Gross Anatomy. The successful applicant must have a Ph.D., DO or MD degree, experience in teaching a clinically-oriented anatomy course, and research experience and/or evidence of scholarship in teaching and learning. Teaching duties will include both lecture and laboratory instruction to first-year medical students and facilitation of 1st and 2nd year problem-based curriculum groups.

This position shares in non-academic tasks for the Anatomy Course that are the responsibility of the Anatomy group as well as other related Academic Administrative duties (committee work course/systems coordinator.) Resources for anatomic research include plastination facility, skeletal preparation resources, a small anatomy museum, and a wide range of media support services. Facilities and start-up funds available for all types of research, including educational research. An excellent fringe benefits package is included.

The position will be filled at the rank of assistant, associate, or full professor, commensurate with educational or teaching experience and research accomplishment. We have particular interest in candidates holding a Doctorate Degree in Anatomy or Medicine, teaching experience in medical histology is a plus.
