## DO 02-2. Policy

- 2.1 All applicants approved for admission to the West Virginia School of Osteopathic Medicine <a href="Doctor of Osteopathy program">Doctor of Osteopathy program</a> will be subject to a criminal background check. The background check shall occur after the second deposit deadline, but prior to matriculation.
- 2.2 A criminal background check shall be conducted on all <u>D.O.</u> students during Year 2 of the program in order to be eligible for promotion to Year 3. Results of the criminal background check shall be made available to the Associate Dean <u>for Predoctoral of Clinical Education</u>, and said results will be shared, upon demand therefore, with affiliated hospitals and clinics which require such reports for acceptance of the students at the affiliated facilities.
- 2.3 No students will be accepted into a Statewide Campus site without completion of such criminal background check.
