Dependent Care/Special Services

As part of the financial aid student expected expense budget, we are allowed to include figures based on expenses reasonably incurred for dependent care.

“Dependent” in this instance refers to a person in the student’s household. It may be a child/children and/or an elderly or disabled adult.

A spouse who is not elderly or disabled does not qualify as a dependent in this instance.

If you are requesting an increase in your budget for dependent care and are married, you must:

- Provide proof of spouse’s employment;
- Provide proof of cost of dependent care.

If you require special services, transportation, equipment or supplies that are not provided for by other agencies (and are not covered by health insurance), you may provide documentation of these needs and their costs and they can be added to your budget. Please attach required documentation.
